Class 12 in Yelagiri

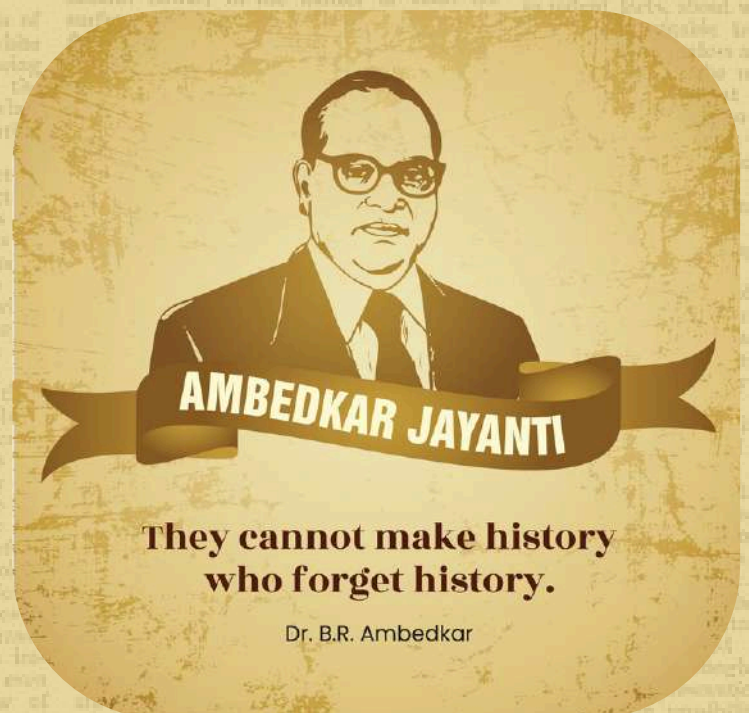
