

Ambedkar Jayanti, also known as Bhim Jayanti, is observed on **14th April** to commemorate the memory of Dr.B. R. Ambedkar, Indian politician and social reformer. It marks Dr. Ambedkar's birthday who was born on 14th April 1891. His birthday is also referred to as Equality Day by some in India.

Dr. Ambedkar is well-known for his relentless fight against the social discrimination faced by Dalits (formerly known as "Untouchables") and other marginalized communities. He advocated for the abolition of the caste system and untouchability, which were deeply entrenched in Indian society. As the Chairman of the Drafting Committee of the Indian Constitution, Dr. Ambedkar played a pivotal role in framing the Constitution of India, which came into effect on 26th January 1950. The Constitution enshrines the principles of justice, liberty, and equality for all citizens, irrespective of caste, creed, or religion.


