On **27th July 2025**, the Industrial Waste Management Association (IWMA) in collaboration with the Science Olympiad Federation (SOF) organized a workshop on "Popularizing of Science – Hands-on Training in Nanoscience" at the National Centre for Nanoscience and Nanotechnology, University of Madras, Guindy Campus. **Health Camp**
