Skill on Wheels



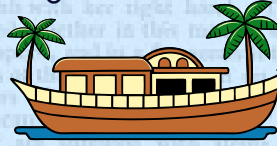

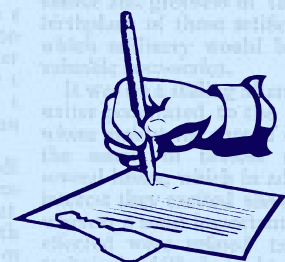


Birla Planetarium Class 3
